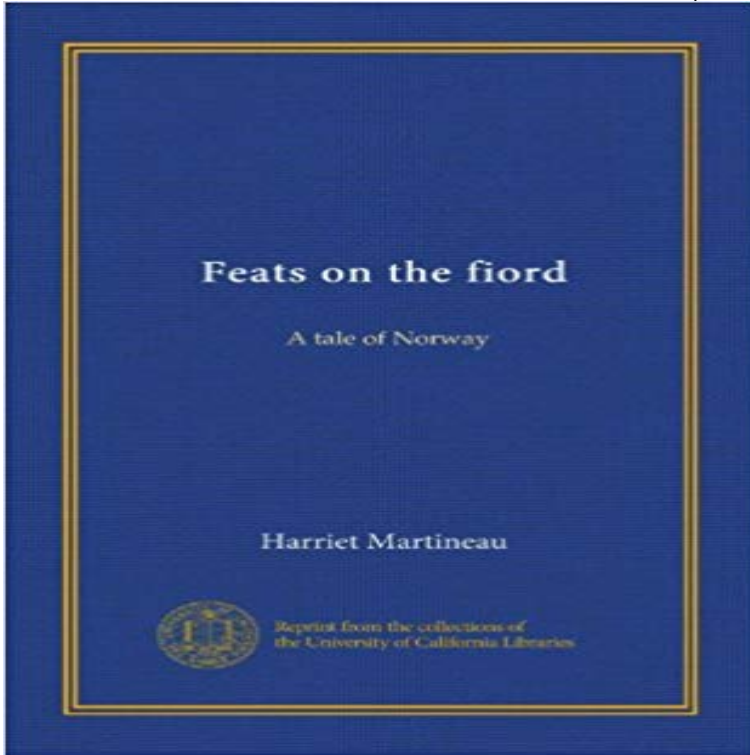


Feats on the fiord: A tale of Norway
