
The Metamorphosis (Special Illustrated Edition): one of the seminal works of fiction of the 20th century



The Metamorphosis (German: Die Verwandlung) is a novella by Franz Kafka, first published in 1915. It has been cited as one of the seminal works of fiction of the 20th century and is studied in colleges and universities across the Western world. The story begins with a traveling salesman, Gregor Samsa, waking to find himself transformed (metamorphosed) into a large, monstrous insect-like creature. The cause of Samsas transformation is never revealed, and Kafka himself never gave an explanation. The rest of Kafkas novella deals with Gregors attempts to adjust to his new condition as he deals with being burdensome to his parents and sister, who are repulsed by the horrible, verminous creature Gregor has become.

The story follows Gregor Samsa, a traveling salesman who works to provide for his parents and sister.
