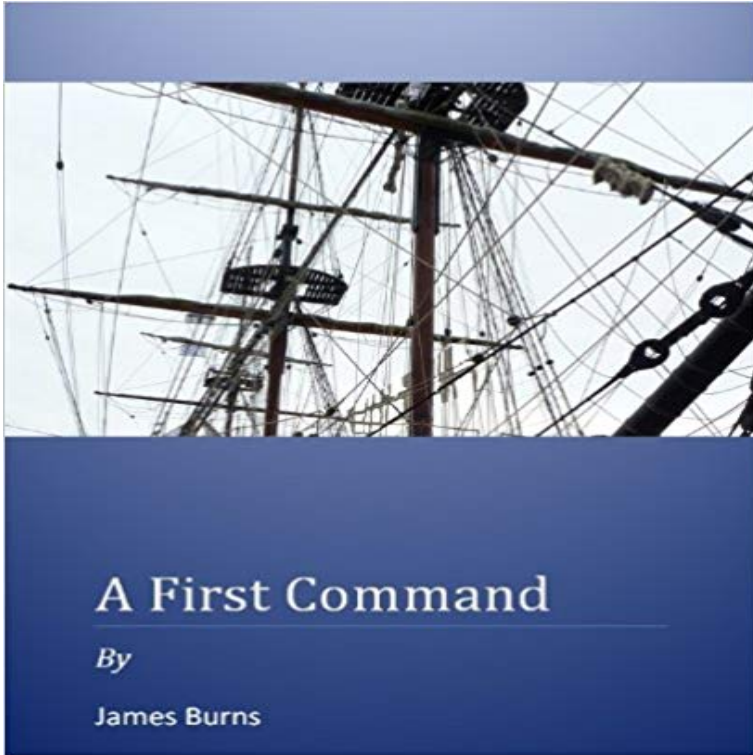


A First Command
