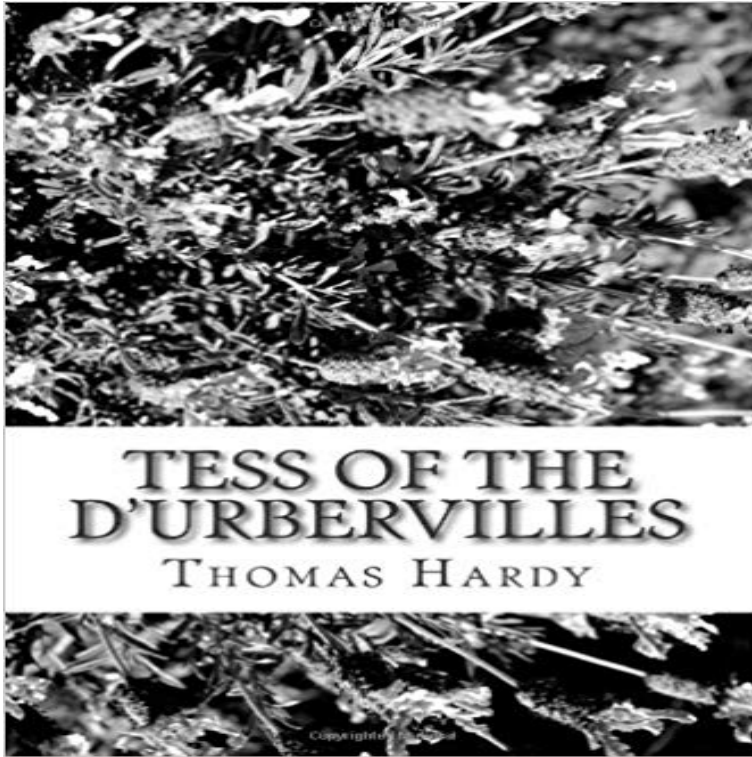


Tess of the dUrbervilles
