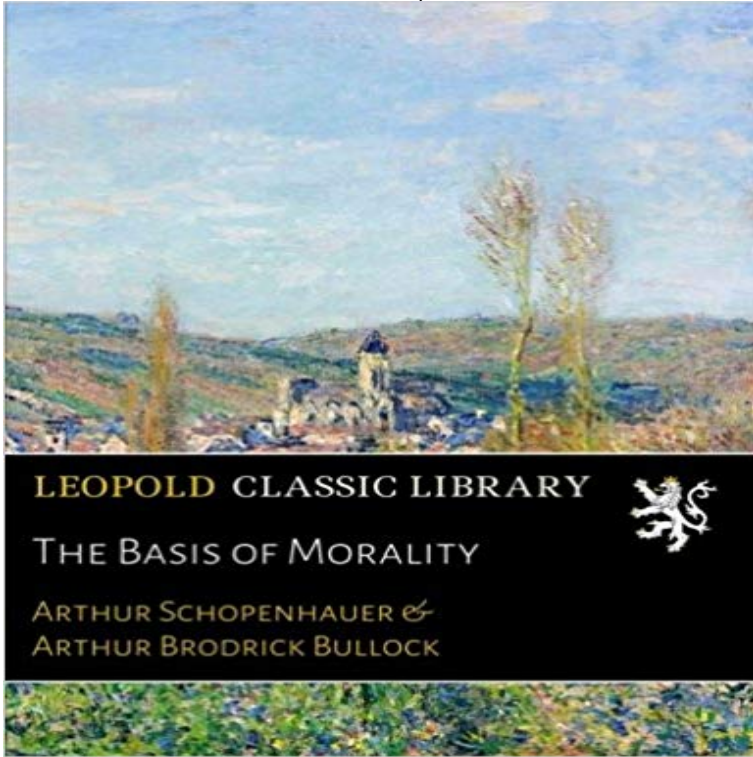


The Basis of Morality
