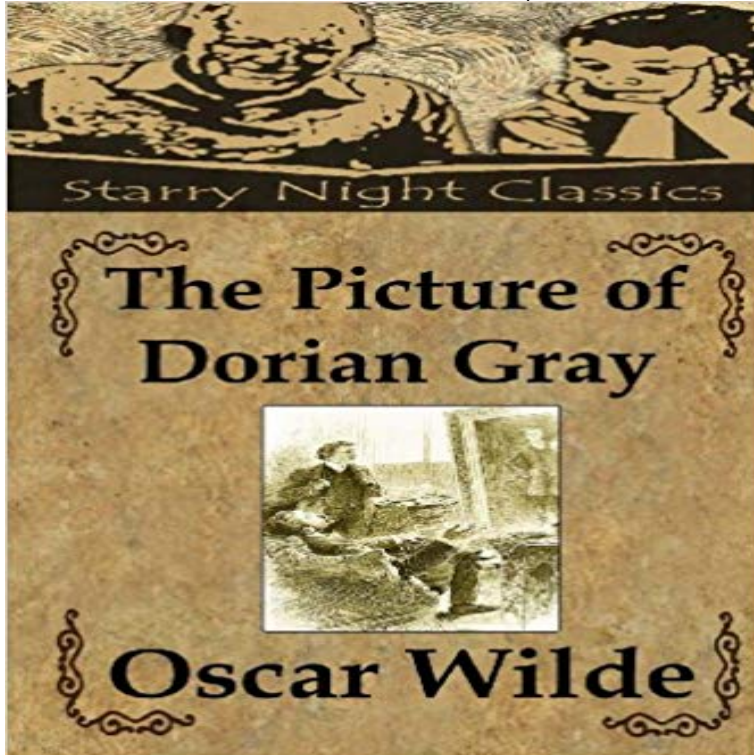


The Picture of Dorian Gray
